Summer 2023 ME 699 – ME Topics Course Descriptions

ME 699, Section C, 12232 - Graphics Practicum

Prerequisite: ME 212 – Engineering Graphics

Counts as 300-level ME Tech Elective. Does not count towards 600-level ME Tech Elective.

This course covers advanced 3D CAD features and solid modeling techniques including an introduction to sheet metals, multi-body parts, weldments, etc. The topics covered will meet the requirements for the CSWP-Mechanical Design exam. After successfully completing this course, students will be able to:

- 1. Model sheet metals, multi-body parts, weldments.
- 2. Use linked dimensions and equations to aid in modeling
- 3. Use advanced SolidWorks features such as, creating configurations from other configurations, deform features, Macros.
- 4. Use basic and advanced assembly features
